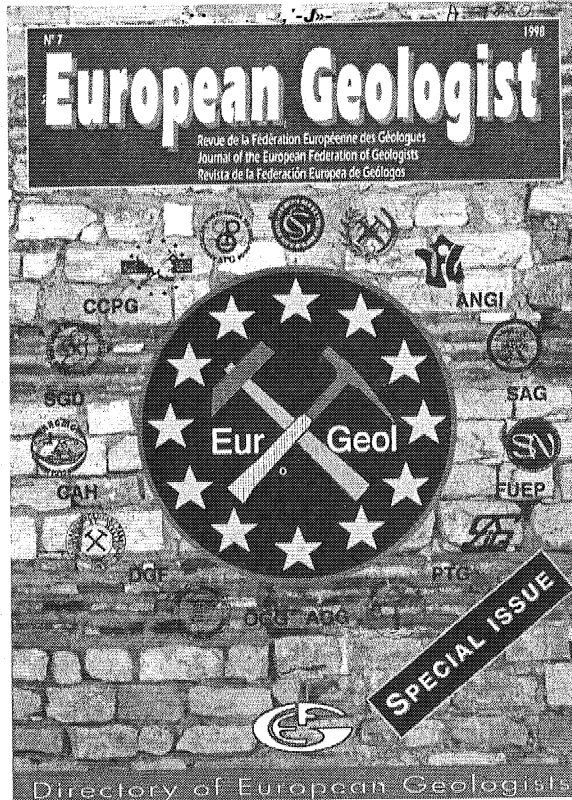

The Chamber is the only legal professional organization of the geological engineers who have the rights of all kinds of professional applications and depending on the Article 135 of the Republic of Turkey Constitution, it is a professional organization which has public establishment character.
The Chamber aims to realize several activities in order to contribute the evaluation of natural resources of our country according to the benefits of public and country, identify and develop the authority and responsibilities of its members and for increasing the effectiveness of the profession on several subjects such as Mining Geology, Petroleum Geology, Hydrogeology, Marine Geology, Engineering Geology, Environmental Geology, Urbanisation, Drilling, and the other engineering applications to establish the development of geologist engineering training, to organize technical congress, symposiums, seminars, conferences and exhibitions which are necessary for professional development, to advocate the economic and democratic rights of its members.
