

RULES FOR POSTER PREPARATION

1. Posters should be 70 (horizontal) x 100 (vertical) cm in size and in one piece.
2. Posters should be sent in **pdf format, 72 DPI** and **1 MB** to the address **sekreter73.tjk@jmo.org.tr**. Posters will be uploaded to the system by the Organizing Committee.
3. 1 cm margins must be left from the top, bottom, right and left edges of the poster page.
4. The name and logo of the Congress must be placed in the upper left corner of the poster. The logo can be found from the "**Congress Documents**" link at **tjk.jmo.org.tr**.
5. Text on posters should be written using an easy-to-read writing style. The title of the poster should be written in 60-pt and bold, and care should be taken that the title does not exceed two lines. 30-pt and bold letters for author names and contact addresses and 16-18-pt letters for other parts should be used and the name of the author who will present the poster should be underlined.
6. It should be preferred to give the text in two columns with figures in between.
7. Section titles in the text should be written in 24-pt and bold.
8. Posters should consist of sections such as **introduction, method, findings, results and discussion**, and at the end, references should be specified in a directory with smaller-pt.
9. There is no color limitation in the preparation of posters, and the use of colorful figures and photographs that increase the visuality should be focused. In order for the characters to be easily read, characters of appropriate size should be used in the figures, and the same characters should be preferred in all figures. Figures should be given in sizes that can be easily seen.

POSTER PRESENTATION

1. Posters will be uploaded to the "Poster Presentations" section at **tjk.jmo.org.tr** and announced by the Congress Organizing Committee.
2. Poster owners will attend poster sessions at the times and hours specified in the program and provide information about their work in case of questions.
3. At the end of the congress, posters will remain on the congress web-page, but can be removed with the author's request.
